



Easter Project



STEP 1

Take your craft or wrapping paper and wrap it around the toilet roll tube, cut off any overhanging excess and then cover the back of the paper in glue. Wrap the paper around the tube again and press down gently all around until the paper stays in place.

STEP 2

Next we are going to make a set of ears with the patterned card. Turn the card over and draw a pair of ears, one standing straight up and the second leaning slightly to one side.



STEP 3

Cut out the ears carefully and then use your pink Lionheart Colour Broad Marker to fill in a centre strip over the pattern of the card.

STEP 4

Glue or tape the bottom of the ears inside the tube like this.



STEP 5

Draw two circles on your white sticky label, they are going to be the eyes so they need to be the same size



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STEP 6

Cut out the circles.



STEP 7

Use your black marker to draw two small circles opposite each other on both stickers. Then colour in the eyes in black, leaving the four white circles showing.



STEP 8

Peel the stickers off the backing sheet and stick them in place on the front of the tube below the ears. Use the pink marker to add a cute nose and rosy cheeks and then draw a couple of eyelashes on each eye and a mouth with the black marker.



STEP 9

Draw two arms on the back of the patterned card you used for the ears and cut them out. Glue the reverse side and stick them in place either side of the bunny.

NOW YOU KNOW HOW TO MAKE THIS BUNNY YOU CAN MAKE A WHOLE FAMILY OF THEM! USE DIFFERENT COLOUR PAPER FOR EACH ONE AND TRY DRAWING DIFFERENT EXPRESSIONS TOO. YOU CAN ALSO USE KITCHEN ROLL TUBES TO MAKE LARGER BUNNIES AND YOU COULD CUT THE TOILET ROLL TUBES IN HALF TO MAKE BABY ONES!
