SAY SOMETHING SPECIAL

There are lots of ways you can say something special to someone, a card, a letter, email, text, phone call or telling them in person but the best way for a child to share a special message is through a piece of art. Kids love to draw so why not get them to create something for their best friend or favourite family member this summer?

You Will Need

- Duotip Markers
- Metallic Marker
- Handwriting pen
- A4 paper or card
- A5 paper or card
- Pencil
- Glue
- A4 picture frame (optional)

Project time: 30 minutes

Project level: Beginners - great for children!

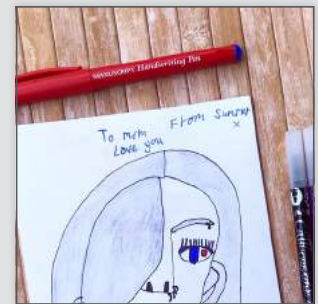


Step 1

Ask your child to draw something on the A5 sized paper. They can either do this with the Duotip markers or start drawing with a pencil and then use the markers to add some colour afterward.

Step 2

Ask them to write their message somewhere on the drawing using a handwriting pen.



Step 3

Glue the drawing into the centre of the A4 paper or card leaving a border all the way around the outside.

Step 4

Now its time to decorate the border. Give them the metallic marker to draw an ornate frame around their artwork. If you are going to use a picture frame place the drawing inside it otherwise it is ready to be given to the lucky person.
