



STAINED GLASS JAR

Our Callicreative Craft markers work on lots of different surfaces including glass. Why don't you have a go at making this candle jar with a pack and an empty jar from your kitchen? They are perfect for using outside in the evening on a patio table or on top of a wall as the height of the jar protects the candle from going out and the colours really shine brightly with a flame behind them!

YOU WILL NEED:


- Callicrative Craft markers
- Empty glass jar
- Washi or masking tape
- Tealight candle

Project Time: 1 hour includind drying time

Project Level: Beginner









Craft Project



STEP 1

Take your glass jar and use thin strips of tape to create shapes and sections like a mosaic.

STEP 2

Continue this pattern until you have covered the whole jar. Make sure to stick the tape down firmly so there is no gap between it and the glass surface underneath.





STEP 3


Use the red, blue, green, yellow and white Craft markers to colour in each section of the jar.

STEP 4

Leave the ink to dry for about 15 minutes and then carefully peel off all the tape.

STEP 5

Use the black Crafter marker to fill in the clear lines all the way around the jar.



STEP 6

Leave the black ink to dry for another 15 minutes to avoid smudging.




STEP 7


Put a tealight candle inside the jar and light it to see all the colours come to life.
