



Valentine's Craft Project

LOVE TO SCRAPBOOK

It's February and that means one thing... love is in the air! Today we are going to show you how to create a Valentine's themed scrapbook spread to record all your favourite things about the special someone in your life.

You Will Need

- Callicreative Flexi Markers
- Callicreative Duotip Markers
- Red Wick Wax
- Heart Sealing Coin & Handle
- Scrapbook
- Decorative tape, two different designs
- Glue
- Scrapbook embellishments (paper pocket, note cards, quote or journaling cards, flower petals, stickers, etc.)
- Matches or a lighter

Project time: 30 minutes
Project level: Beginner









Step 1

Tear two strips of decorative tape from the rolls, make one a little shorter than the other. Stick the longest strip along the top edge of the left hand page and then place the shorter strip underneath the first. Repeat this step along the bottom edge of the right hand page, placing the longest piece on the bottom and the shorter strip above it.

Step 2

Use the red and pink Duotip Markers to draw a row of small hearts along the bottom edge of the left hand page. Alternate between the two colours until you are about half way across the page.





Step 3


On the right hand page use a Callicreative Flexi Marker to write the word "Love" along the top edge. Start on the left and stretch the word out across to the other side with a couple of long flourishes. The Flexi Tip is perfect for this kind of lettering project!

Step 4

Select your favourite photo of you and your other half and glue it into position on the right hand page. We've marked this space with some pink arrows on our spread.









Step 5

Add some of your embellishments to the rest of the right hand page. We've used a journaling tag, heart sticker and some artificial rose petals. You can also draw some more small hearts with the Duotip markers above the strips of decorative tape if you have any space left.

Step 6

Use the Duotip Markers to write "We go together like... coffee and donuts" on a small note card or piece of paper.





Step 7


Glue the note card or paper on to the paper pocket. Then glue the pocket on the left hand page of the spread.

Step 8

Glue a quote or journaling card onto the page, next to the paper pocket. Leave an empty space above the card and below the decorate tape for the wax seal.









Step 9

Light the wick on the red wax with either a match or lighter and drip the melting wax into the empty space until you have a pool big enough to stamp.

Step 10

Quickly check you have the wax seal the right way round and then press it slowly into the centre of the melted wax. Hold it in the same position for about 30 seconds while the wax hardens and then remove the seal carefully.





Step 11

Use some embellishments to add the finishing touches to the page.

Your spread is now ready to fill in! Add any love letters, ticket stubs or small bits of memorabilia into the paper pocket and fill in the journaling tag with a heartfelt message, poem or memory for your loved one!
